### How do I evidence that I have met the challenges?

The BELONG Accreditation is all about developing positive character traits and becoming a responsible and active citizen. So the challenges that you complete are all about you and how you will show that you are developing your character.

Below is the Bronze level of the BELONG Accreditation and how you might show that you have completed the challenges. It could be that you actually come up with an even better way of showing that you have met that challenge.

Ultimately, it is your PD Tutor who signs you off at each level so if in doubt ask them what they want to see.

Remembering being proud to be your best means that you are preparing for adulthood to be the best that you can be and we want to celebrate every achievement that you make.

Attend a sporting after school club for six weeks.	Take a photo at your sporting club, with you teacher's permission. Get your teacher to sign you planner to say that you have attended the group for six weeks. Then, go and show your PD Tutor and get your achievement!
Successfully complete the Personal Development curriculum package with your PD Tutor including mental health awareness.	Complete your PD tasks in your book to the best of your ability. Show your PD Tutor that you have taken pride in your work. Ask your PD Tutor if you think that your work has met the BELONG Target!
Take part in a fitness activity either in school or outside school at least once a week for a half term.	Share a photo with your PD Tutor via email or with the School's Social Media sites to evidence your attendance at the fitness class. Ask an instructor or organiser of the group to pass on that you have attended the class for a full half term and that you deserve your achievement. Ask your PD Tutor for the achievement!
Support staff in raising awareness of the importance of mental health, the LGBTQ+ community or any other current campaigns.	Attend LGBTQ+ group and complete the activities, take a friend or speak to the organiser about how you can help. Ask the teacher to sign your planner to say that you deserve this achievement. Show your PD Tutor to get the achievement.
Achieve your fitness goal on your phone for 7 consecutive days.	Set yourself a goal that is challenging for you, it could be 10,000 steps or 450 active calories or any other goal that pushes you to make healthy choices. Take a screenshot and share it with your PD Tutor or the School's Social Media Sites. Ask your PD Tutor to give you the achievement.

Have at least 96% attendance and no more than 5 'late to school' marks across the year.	Your attendance is monitored throughout the year. Keep an eye on your percentage and keep it as high as possible. Ask your PD Tutor what your attendance is.
Attend a creative after school club for six weeks (e.g., Music, Dance, Drama, Art).	Ask the teacher who organises your club after school to sign a note in your planner that you have attended for six weeks and show it to you PD Tutor to sign it off.
You have received a positive phone call home or above 150 achievement points in a half term.	Remind your subject teacher how brilliantly you have been doing in class and ask them if you deserve a positive phone call home. Ask your PD Tutor for the achievement once you achieve that phone call!
Receive an outstanding 'Attitude to Learning' score in 5 subjects.	Review you report home in your planner and count those outstanding ATLS! Show your PD Tutor and sign off the achievement.
Work with students that you do not usually work with and receive a positive point for your work as a team.	When you have worked well as a team in class let your teacher know that you are looking for this achievement. Write a not in your planner and ask for your teacher to sign it. So your PD teacher and get this achievement signed off.

<p>Be rewarded for keeping Whitcliffe Mount tidy on at least 4 occasions.</p>	<p>Tidy your area in the Restaurant without being prompted and remind a teacher on duty your looking for this achievement. Have your PD Tutor check you achievements and get this achievement signed off.</p>
<p>Make a positive contribution to school life by volunteering to support an event or role on student leadership.</p>	<p>Volunteer to support an after school event or activity and ask the organiser to let your PD Tutor know that you have been involved and you were proud to represent the school.</p>
<p>Help a friend to resolve an issue in school.</p>	<p>If one of your friends has an issue in school, help them to positively resolve this issue with the help of a member of staff. Remind that member of staff that you are looking for this achievement and ask them to let you PD Tutor know that you have been helping.</p>
<p>Become part of the student leadership team.</p>	<p>Successfully join the student leadership team and ask your PD Tutor to sign it off.</p>
<p>Take part in a House Competition and motivate others to be involved.</p>	<p>Look out for a House Competition that you want to take part in. Ask your friends to join you. Show your PD Tutor what you've done and get signed off for this achievement!</p>

<p>Attend one daytime trip or visit during the academic year (academic or cultural).</p>	<p>Take opportunity be part of a daytime visit through your time at school. Remind your PD Tutor that you are still waiting for this achievement and get it signed off.</p>
<p>Complete your profile quiz on Unifrog to begin your careers journey.</p>	<p>Go online and log onto your Unifrog account and search for the profile quizzes and complete them. Send your PD Tutor an email to tell them what the quiz decides you're interested in.</p>
<p>Take part in Sports Day in an individual track event and a field event.</p>	<p>Join your Sports Day Team and compete. Taking the opportunity to contribute to the House Competition and making healthy choices. Remind your PD Tutor that you are looking for this achievement.</p>
<p>Take a book out from the LRC and read it, completing a home reading log as evidence.</p>	<p>Take the opportunity to be immersed in a book. Show you PD Tutor your book and your reading log to be signed off for this achievement.</p>
<p>Volunteer to help your Tutor in Personal Development to deliver an activity.</p>	<p>Volunteer to read allowed in PD Time or deliver the quiz or student bulletin to take the opportunity to become more confident to speak aloud.</p>

<p>Receive a positive postcard from a subject teacher for your work in class.</p>	<p>If you think that you have performed particularly well in class or you have met all of the aspects of PROUD and created a work that you think deserves reward. Remind your subject teacher that you are looking to get a postcard to complete this challenge.</p>
<p>Receive an academic, sporting or cultural award from school e.g. The Brilliant Club, Player of the Year.</p>	<p>Believe in yourself and never give up. Strive to be your personal best and receive an award inside or outside of school. Show your subject teacher or better yet email them a picture or tag yourself in the @WMount X account with a photo and description to receive meet this challenge.</p>
<p>Take part in a PD activity which is seen by a wider audience.</p>	<p>If you feel that you have done something in the community that deserves celebration whether that is a parade, a performance, helping out in a community drive then take a photo and share it with your PD Tutor to see if you can achieve this standard.</p>
<p>Sign up to the Duke of Edinburgh Award and begin your volunteering.</p>	<p>Push yourself to be a part of something special. Join the Duke of Edinburgh Award and begin volunteering. Share this with your PD Tutor via a photo on an email or even better upload your photo to Twitter and tag the school @WMount X Account to show that you are proud to be you best.</p>
<p>Receive regular, substantial praise in your books in a number of different subjects over a term (identified by staff and sent to your PD mentor).</p>	<p>If a subject leader or Director of Learning rewards you for your work in a number of subjects ask them to share this with you PD Tutor to achieve this goal.</p>



<p><b>GREAT PRIDE IN YOUR WORK AND COMMUNITY</b></p>	<p><b>How to evidence my achievements</b> <i>Remember the Scholar's Accreditation is all about Personal Development It is your achievement, your responsibility Follow the steps to gather the evidence</i></p>
<p>Donate during a House Charity Event for example to the Cleckheaton Food Bank.</p>	<p>Share with your PD Tutor how you have contributed towards a school charity event. Ask your PD Tutor to sign you off for this challenge.</p>
<p>Take part in an event which raises awareness of a charity or community project e.g., Race for Life.</p>	<p>If you take part in a charity or community project or charity challenge take pride in your achievement and share this with you PD Tutor via email or even better tag the @WMount X Account with your achievement.</p>
<p>Donate old school uniform/PE kit/books, toys and/or games to school for the benefit of the school community.</p>	<p>Be proud to want to contribute to the school community by donating your uniform that is too good to throw away. Share what you have done with your PD Tutor and be proud of your contribution.</p>
<p>Receive a positive award for the pride and resilience shown in your work.</p>	<p>If you believe that you have shown that you are an independent learner who has shown that they are meeting all the aspects of PROUD and has been resilient in trying to complete challenging work, let your teacher know that you are trying to achieve this challenge.</p>
<p>Visit a place of worship or a historical building and show your tutor evidence of your visit.</p>	<p>If you visit a place of worship, a place with historical significance then let your teacher know what was interesting about your visit and what you have learned.</p>
