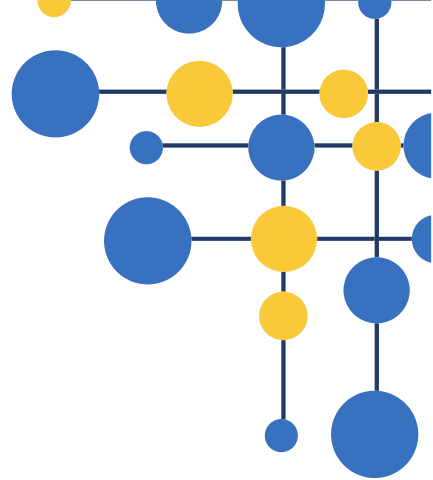

GCSE Examination Results Day

Arrival at school:

- Staff will be on hand to supervise the student entrance.
- Students do not need to attend in uniform.
- Please do not come any earlier as results will not be ready.

We always wish to celebrate outstanding Achievement and Progress, and some students may be contacted on Wednesday 19th August and invited to attend school at a slightly earlier time on Thursday.

If your child(ren) is/are unable to collect their results in person, they can authorise a third party to collect them on their behalf or have these sent by email.

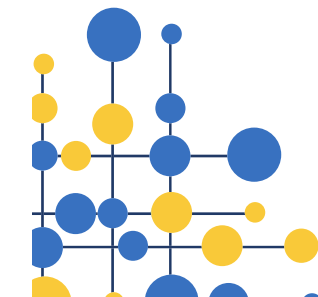

Any nominated person collecting results on behalf of a student must bring a form of photographic identification on the day. If a request for the results by email has been made, results will be emailed after 11.00am on Thursday 20th August, once all other students have collected in person. Unfortunately, we are unable to post results out if they are not collected on results day.

GCSE Certificates will be available to collect from mid-January, and we will email you at this time to arrange collection. These certificates will be required as evidence of your child(ren)s GCSE qualifications in applications for further education and at job interviews throughout their lives. As such, it is important they are collected and kept safe.

If your child(ren) has/have signed up to the Education Records App, their results should become available for them to see via the app and share with colleges and employers in the afternoon of the 20th August.

We very much look forward to celebrating the achievements of all our students, in what we are sure will be a joyous occasion. However, we do understand that for some students there may well be some disappointment to be managed. Therefore, staff will be on site and will be available to talk to students and offer advice on the next steps should they need it. Additionally, to ensure students are aware of all their options, a careers advisor from C&K careers will be available on results day for careers guidance, along with representatives from Elliott Hudson and Kirklees College.

If your child(ren) misses out on any of the grades, they need for their chosen post 16 course, they will need to contact the college/school directly; they may be able to offer students alternative courses.
