Parental Letter - School Day 2023/2024

We would like to share with you an update on our timing of the school day consultation so that you and your child(ren) can plan ahead for the academic year of 23/24 and beyond. Thank you for the feedback shared; we have had an overwhelming number of responses which allowed us to make informed decisions. We gathered feedback from students, parents/carers, the catering team and staff to better understand how we could make and support improvements at Whitcliffe Mount School for everyone. It is acknowledged that break time is busy, and students are rushing to get food and go to the toilet. We would like to broaden the kitchen server offer to make it easier and quicker for students to get food. As a result we have lengthened breaktime and increased food options. We will also be introducing 3 minutes of movement time between lessons; this will allow students to swiftly move to lessons without being late to lesson and also use the toilet if required. We have slightly extended and reconfigured form-time so that we can use this time more effectively next year and we will re-name it "Personal Development" on student's timetables.
