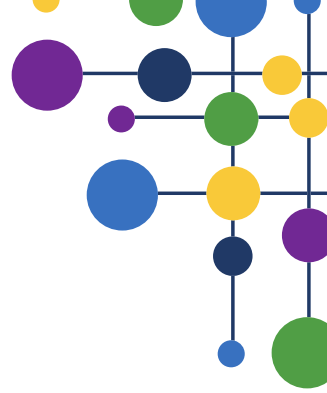


**Information for Year 7 Parent/Carer Personal Development Tutor Evening
