Reading at Whitcliffe Mount School

All students in Years 7 to 11 are assessed annually using the New Group Reading Test (NGRT). Students in Years 7 to 10 being supported on our reading programme will be retested termly until they graduate with a scaled score of 100. A score of 100 means a student is reading at their chronological age.

Students will receive regular phonics support.

Students will be challenged through the curriculum, and supported by our extensively stocked learning resource centre (LRC)
