GCSE Examinations Results Day Arrangements - Reminder

We hope you are enjoying the summer (despite the mixed weather) and that your children are enjoying some well-earned time off after completing their exams. We are looking forward to seeing them on Thursday for GCSE results day and are writing to remind you of the arrangements. The details for results collection remain the same as in the letter dated July 4th 2024.

GCSE examinations results day is **Thursday 22nd August 2024**. Results will be available to collect from the main hall between **9:00am and 11:00am**.

Arrival at school:

- If arriving by car/taxi, you may use the main school car park to pick up and drop off.
- Staff will be on hand to supervise the student entrance
- Please do not come any earlier as results will not be ready.

If your child(ren) is(are) unable to collect their results in person, they can authorise a third party to collect them on their behalf or have these sent by email. If you would like to receive results via either of these options, **and have not already requested this**, please complete the Results Collection Form here: <https://forms.office.com/e/Njckwh8B85>

Any nominated person collecting results on behalf of a student must bring a form of photographic identification on the day. If a request for these by email has been made, results will be emailed on the afternoon of the 22/8/24 once all other students have collected in person. Unfortunately, we are unable to post results out if they are not collected on results day.

GCSE Certificates will be available to collect from mid-January and we will email you at this time to arrange collection. These certificates will be required as evidence of the GCSE qualifications in applications for further education and at job interviews throughout their lives. As such, it is important they are collected and kept safe.

We very much look forward to celebrating the achievements of all our students, in what we are sure will be a joyous occasion. However, we do understand that for some students there may well be some disappointment to be managed. Therefore, staff will be on site and will be available to talk to students and offer advice on the next steps should they need it.

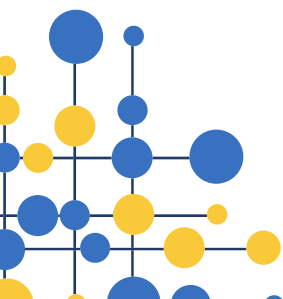

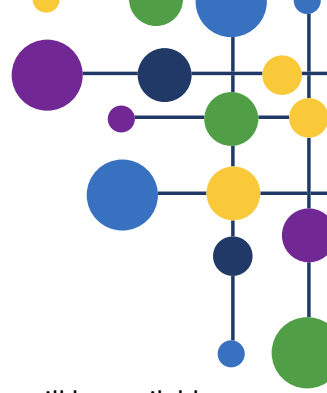
